SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

Effective January 9, 2023



All students must come to school in Coquillard's uniform every day. We have required school uniforms for several very important reasons:

- **Uniforms unite us as a community.** When you look at the Coquillard uniform, it is a powerful visual statement of our community. Students make a commitment that when they put on the Coquillard uniform, they are agreeing to live up to the school's values.
- **Uniforms reduce distractions and clothing competition.** Often students spend more time discussing and evaluating what others are wearing or not wearing than they spend focusing on learning. Wearing uniforms eliminates this distraction.
- **Uniforms make us all equal.** Whether families have high incomes or low incomes, the students come to school looking the same way. No one is made to feel bad about the clothes they have or don't have.
- **Uniforms look professional.** Students look neat when they arrive at school with shirts tucked into their pants. The students come mentally prepared for school and "dressed for work."

UNIFORM POLICY INFORMATION

The Coquillard Elementary uniform consists of:

- Short or long-sleeved navy, royal blue, gold or white tops (Polo, T-Shirt, or Oxford). Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- Optional: undershirts worn under uniform shirts must be navy, royal blue, gold, or white.
- Navy, royal blue, gold, or white crewneck sweatshirts, sweaters, fleece, cardigans, or vests may be worn over uniform shirts. Coats/ jackets are not permitted.
- Pants, slacks, shorts, capris, and skirts must be navy, khaki, or black. Skirts and shorts may be no shorter than two inches (2") above the knee. No sweatpants, nor jean pants/skirts (blue or black) are allowed at any time. Clear blue plaid design for skirts and jumpers from French Toast is permitted.
- Clothing must fit as designed, not oversized or too snug. **No sagging.** No skinny jeans/pants or jeggings. Modifying clothing in any way is not permitted. No torn or ripped clothing.
- Solid brown, black, white, or blue socks/hose/tights.
- Optional: solid navy, royal blue, gold, or white ties may be worn with uniform dress shirts. Clear blue plaid design from French Toast is permitted for ties. No wording, emblems, or caricatures are permitted on ties.

UNIFORM POLICY INFORMATION CONTINUED

The Coquillard Elementary Uniform Accessories:

- Modest jewelry is permitted.
- Students wearing pants with belt loops must wear a belt (brown, black, or tan/brown) with a standard belt buckle.
- Black or white shoes with matching rubber soles must be worn.
- Footwear must be closed-toe and closed-heels. Shoe laces must match footwear and be tied. (No slide-on, flip-flops, slippers, moccasins, toe shoes, Crocs, or sports sandals of any kind). Velcro straps must be woven through a loop and secured/closed.

The following are NOT permitted to be worn at school, on the school campus, or at school events:

- Revealing or suggestive clothing
- Clothing & jewelry containing messages or images about alcohol, drugs, tobacco, violence, cults, racism, profanity, gang membership, or suggestive content
- Hats, bandannas, sweatbands, hairnets, “do-rags”, or headscarves
- Other items or styles that are not in the spirit of the uniform policy that draw undue attention to a student or cause distractions to the educational environment

ENFORCEMENT POLICY

NOTIFICATION PROCESS:

All families will receive written correspondence regarding the Coquillard Elementary uniform policy and enforcement procedures. Additionally, the school uniform policy will be posted on Class Dojo and Coquillard's social media sites. New enrollees will receive a copy of the uniform policy upon registration.

EXCEPTIONS:

- When a student's parents or guardians have secured an exemption from the uniform program
- While an appeal of an exemption is pending under the described School Uniform Policy
- During the first five days after transferring from a non-uniform school within the district or from outside the district
- When a student is on campus outside of normal school hours, unless otherwise requested by the school
- The school principal or designee shall have the discretion to determine "flexible uniform days" to allow students/student organizations to have special dress up or casual days.
